



Highway junction and car park access to be confirmed

Entrance signage

Temporary shelter

Drystone walling with feature trees

Remnant hedgerow used as basis to reinforce roadside boundary - native species hedgerow with post and wire fence to demarcate/secure park boundary

Grid planted willow/hazel for coppicing. Attractive roadside feature utilising coloured winter stems of willow species. Managed for wildlife value

Existing trees retained & supplemented with native plantings

Wet/ marshy area to receive run off from any hardstanding areas - lined to maintain damp /flush meadow. Boardwalk through area provides different walking experience

Potential for mobile catering unit

Existing former depot repurposed as a Cycle/Walking Hub. Potential bike hire and education centre using repurposed shipping containers

Entrance signage

Potential future canal link

Rare breed grazing/ Event space

Willow maze

Natural Play Area

Event space/ meadow with grassland managed for biodiversity/hay meadow

Bike trails in short loops for family use - linking into longer distance links wider afield

Existing woodland to be managed to enhance species mix and improve biodiversity

Informal paths tracks with sample stone walling, hurdle making and laid hedgerow replicating 'green lane' /drover's road

Potential for future link onto the former railway. Cycling and walking

Existing mounding utilised for viewing point with paths leading up for a circular walk

Japanese knotweed - monitor and maintain as open grassed bank for ease management

Former railway potential for future links into wider area
