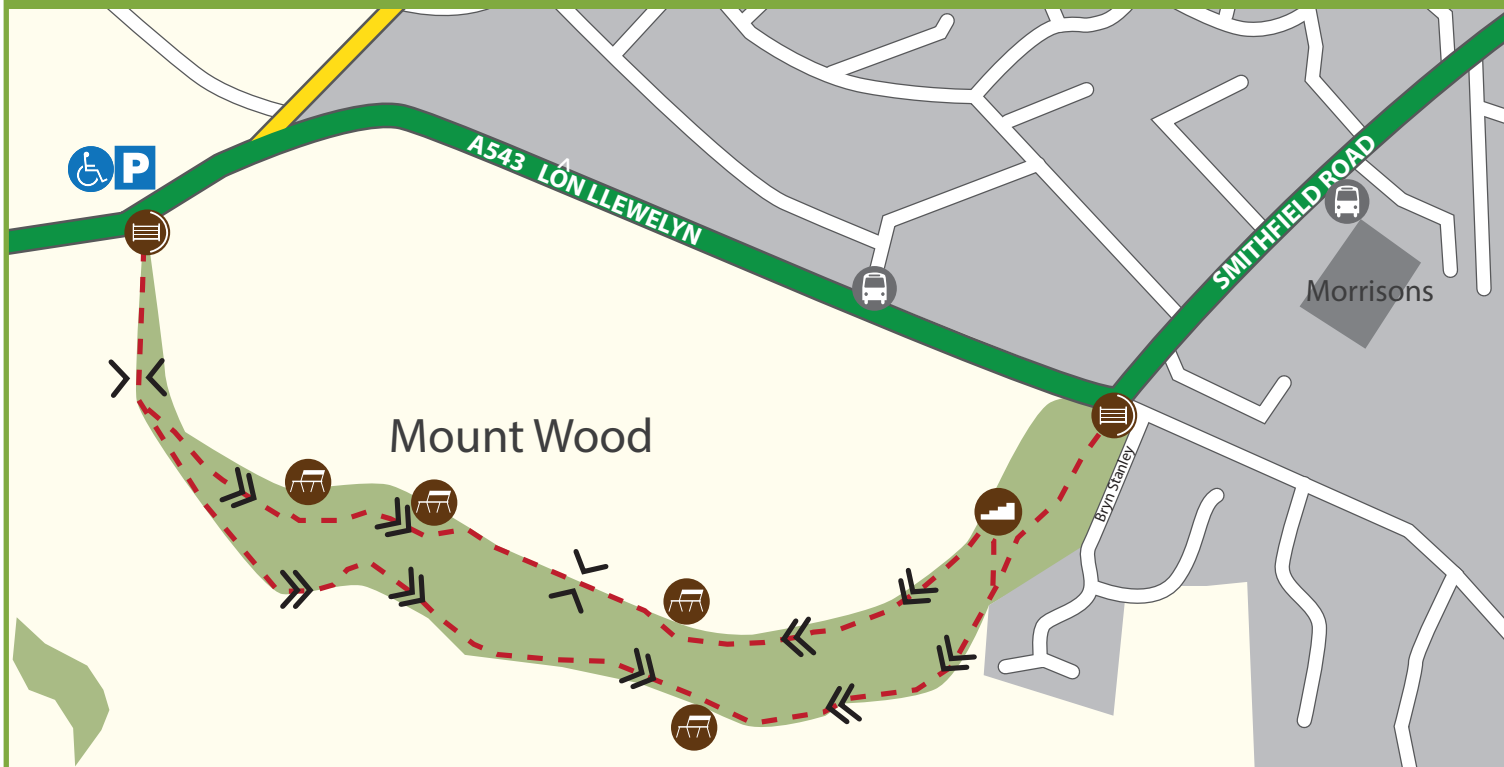

Route Information

A linear lower level route may be taken through the woodland. The viewpoint on the higher level may be reached by the ramps.

Distance: Lower Route - 1km / 0.6 miles
Higher Circular Route - 1.5km / 1 mile

Allow: 30 - 40 minutes.

Surface: Compacted limestone.

Path Width: Minimum 80cm.

Slopes: The path has natural slopes throughout.

Gates: Radar kissing gates, 1 metre clearance.

Ramps: Steep ramps with wooden rails on higher route.

Steps: Located on shortcuts between higher and lower paths

Bring waterproof clothing and wear appropriate footwear. In summer months wear sunscreen.

For Public Transport users: Services 62 and 76 stop at Morrison's. Most services stop at Lantern Pool at the bottom of Smithfield Road. Please see www.traveline-cymru.info to plan your journey.

Parking: Large layby on the A543 (Lon Llewelyn) at the western side of Mount Wood and small car park at Bryn Stanley.

Toilets: There are no toilets on site. The nearest facilities are located at Morrison's Supermarket on Smithfield Road.
