Route Information

A linear route along a wide tarmac path may be taken through the nature reserve.

Distance: 0.7 miles/1km **Allow:** 30 – 45 minutes

Surface: Tarmac.

Wooden Bollards: Minimum 110cm between wooden bollards.

Slopes: Slopes gently at each end of the reserve.

Steps: There is a set of 10 steps with wooden handles.

For Public Transport users: There is a bus stop immediately outside the car park on Station Road. Please see www.traveline-cymru.info to plan your journey.

Parking: Is free. There are no parking bays.

Toilets: There are no toilets on site.

Refreshment: Refreshments are available at nearby Rhuddlan Castle. There are also two restaurants located across the road from the car park.

Bring waterproof clothing and wear appropriate footwear. In summer months wear sunscreen.
