

Disgrifiad:

Mae'r daith hon yn cychwyn o fan Claddu yn dyddio o Oes yr Efydd, ym mhen gogleddol Llyn Brenig. Bu cloddiadau archeolegol helaeth yma yn 1970au, ac mae'r carneddau a ailadeiladwyd i'w gweld yn glir heddiw. Mae'r llwybr yn dringo at gronfa ddŵr bach Clywedog, a mynd ar hyd dyffryn serth gyda golygfeydd syfrdanol o Fryniau Clwyd. Mae'n dilyn llwybr prydferth Afon Clywedog i bentref hardd Cyffylliog, cyn dringo eto at olygfau Pincyn Llys. Yna, mae'r llwybr yn dilyn amryw o draciau coedwig drwy Goedwig Clocaenog, heibio carneddau hynafol a cheffylau Przewalski cyn cyrraedd Bod Petryal, un o'r rhannau hynaf y goedwig.

Description:

This walk starts from the Bronze Age burial ground at the north end of Llyn Brenig. Extensive archaeological excavations took place in the 1970s and the cairns, which were reconstructed, are still clearly visible today. The route climbs to the small Clywedog Reservoir and follows a steep valley, with stunning views over the Clwydian Range. It follows the beautiful Afon Clywedog to the pretty village of Cyffylliog before climbing again to reach the viewpoint at Pincyn Llys. The path then follows a variety of forest tracks through Clocaenog Forest, past ancient cairns and Przewalski horses to reach Bod Petryal, one of the oldest parts of the forest.

Distance: 21 km, 13 miles

Time: 4.5 – 6.5 hours

Start: Llyn Brenig Archaeological Trail, SJ983575 and Bod Petryal, SH037512

Map: OS Explorer 264

Bus Services: 72 – Brenig Bus.

This walk is best accessed by catching a morning bus to either end of the route and returning on the afternoon bus from the other end. *Please note that the Brenig Bus is grant funded and the timetable may be subject to change. Please check on www.traveline-cymru.info for up to date information.*
