# Loggerheads Riverside Trail

## Route Information

**Distance:** 1km / ½ mile **Allow:** 20 – 30 minutes

**Surface:** Compacted limestone, which may become muddy along the trail. Paths around the buildings are surfaced with tarmac.

**Slopes:** Small undulations around the trail – maximum ascent/descent is xxcm behind the old buildings

**Bridges:** Minimum width is 140cm

**Access:** Narrowest access point is 111cm

**Parking:** The tarmac car park is pay and display and includes four disabled parking bays.

**For Public Transport users:** The bus stop is located immediately outside the park. Services 1A, 1, 2, and X1 stop here.
