### Route Information

A linear route taking in the canal between Llangollen Pavilion and the Canal Bridge.

**Distance:** 7km **Allow:** 1-2 hours

**Surface:** Compacted stone with a loose surface in some places.

**Slopes:** Short ramps at each end allowing access to the tow path.

**Path Width:** Minimum 70 cm.

**Kissing Gate:** Clearance of 80cm

**Water Hazards:** Canal immediately next to path with no barriers.

**For Satellite Navigation please use:** LL20 8SW

**For Public Transport users:** Bus service 5 stops outside the Pavilion and the Sun Inn Trevor. Please see [www.traveline-cymru.info](http://www.traveline-cymru.info) to plan your journey.

**Parking:** The tarmac car park is pay and display with four disabled parking bays.

**Toilets:** Toilets are available at the Pavilion (weekdays 9am - 5pm and during events at weekends), Wharf Tea Rooms and Sun Inn Trevor.

**Other amenities:** Refreshments are available from the Sun Inn, Trevor and Llangollen Wharf Tea Rooms. From here you may also take horse drawn boat trips along the canal.

Bring waterproof clothing and wear appropriate footwear. In summer months wear sunscreen.
