Route Information

Linear routes of varying length may be taken. The full circular route is 15.2km and involves some heather moorland and rough terrain.

Distance: Up to 15.2km / 9.5 miles.

Allow: Up to 6 hours for the full circular route.

Gates: Minimum 110cm clearance.

Slopes: Mostly moderate with one narrow section, which is uneven and rocky.

Path width: One access point reduces the path width to 60cm.

Path surface: Combination forest track, tarmac and natural peat / soil.

Parking: Parking is available at the visitor centre where there are four disabled parking bays. This is a pay and display car park. Parking is also located at various other locations around the lake.

For Public Transport users: Some services stop at the visitor centre. See www.traveline-cymru.info to plan your journey.

Toilets: The disabled toilet at the visitor centre requires a radar key for access.

Bring waterproof clothing and wear appropriate footwear. In summer months wear sunscreen.
